
Credit Management Apprentice! LEVEL 4 (18 months) - Unipart Rail!

Unipart Rail are looking for an apprentice to join their busy Finance department in their Doncaster office. Unipart Rail are a logistics company who work with many of the UK Rail companies and some abroad, supplying products, providing servicing, innovating new products for the industry and providing lean solutions.

The apprentice will specialise in Credit Management at Unipart Rail, but will be put through the Professional Accountancy Level 4 apprentice scheme at Doncaster College where they will learn all the necessary skills for the role as well as improving their knowledge in other areas of Finance.

The apprenticeship will last 18 months - the successful applicant will have a programme which will include balancing college assignments with office work. We will also support our candidate through a range of internal training.

Individuals in the role of a Professional Accounting will learn and then have responsibility for creating, and /or verifying and reviewing, accurate and timely financial information within the organisation in which they are employed or on behalf of another organisation. This will be performed in order to meet relevant ethical, professional and legal standards, and will utilise the individual's knowledge of the business systems and processes, as well as standard accounting and tax practices.

The salary for this role is £16,622 per annum.

The apprenticeship will teach you how to:

- Analyse relevant legislation and contract law that has an impact on the credit control environment
- Critically analyse information from a variety of sources to assess credit risk and grant credit in compliance with organisational policies and procedures
- Evaluate a range of techniques to collect debts
- Critically evaluate credit control in line with organisational policies and procedures
- Present advice and recommendations to management on the credit control system

Key Requirements for this role are:

- Completed AAT Level 3 qualification
- Maths and English Grade C or above

An assessment day will be held at the end of August for this apprenticeship to start in September 2017.
