

Unipart Rail Health and Safety Policy Statement



We will adopt a proactive approach to the assessment of risks and opportunities to eliminate workplace hazards. We are committed to continual improvement of our occupational health and safety management system to enhance performance through use of the Unipart Way tools and techniques. We will consult and participate with workers and associated workers' representatives through our internal communication processes and statutory committees.

Health and Safety Objectives

Our Health and Safety policy provides a framework for our objectives that are regularly reviewed to ensure that our improvement programmes and actions effectively implement our policy. Our objectives are:

- To take all measures to comply with all relevant legal requirements and other requirements
- To identify, monitor and measure our significant risks and opportunities and set improvement targets
- To prevent accidents resulting in work related injury and occupational ill health
- To minimise loss caused by near miss, property and equipment damage, fire and breaches of security
- To maintain buildings, plant and equipment to comply with current legislative requirements
- To provide and communicate training, instruction and information to maintain a level of competency throughout Unipart Rail
- To ensure adequate resources are available to maintain and continually improve the health and safety management system
- To conduct an annual review of our objectives, targets and performance and where necessary update this policy.
